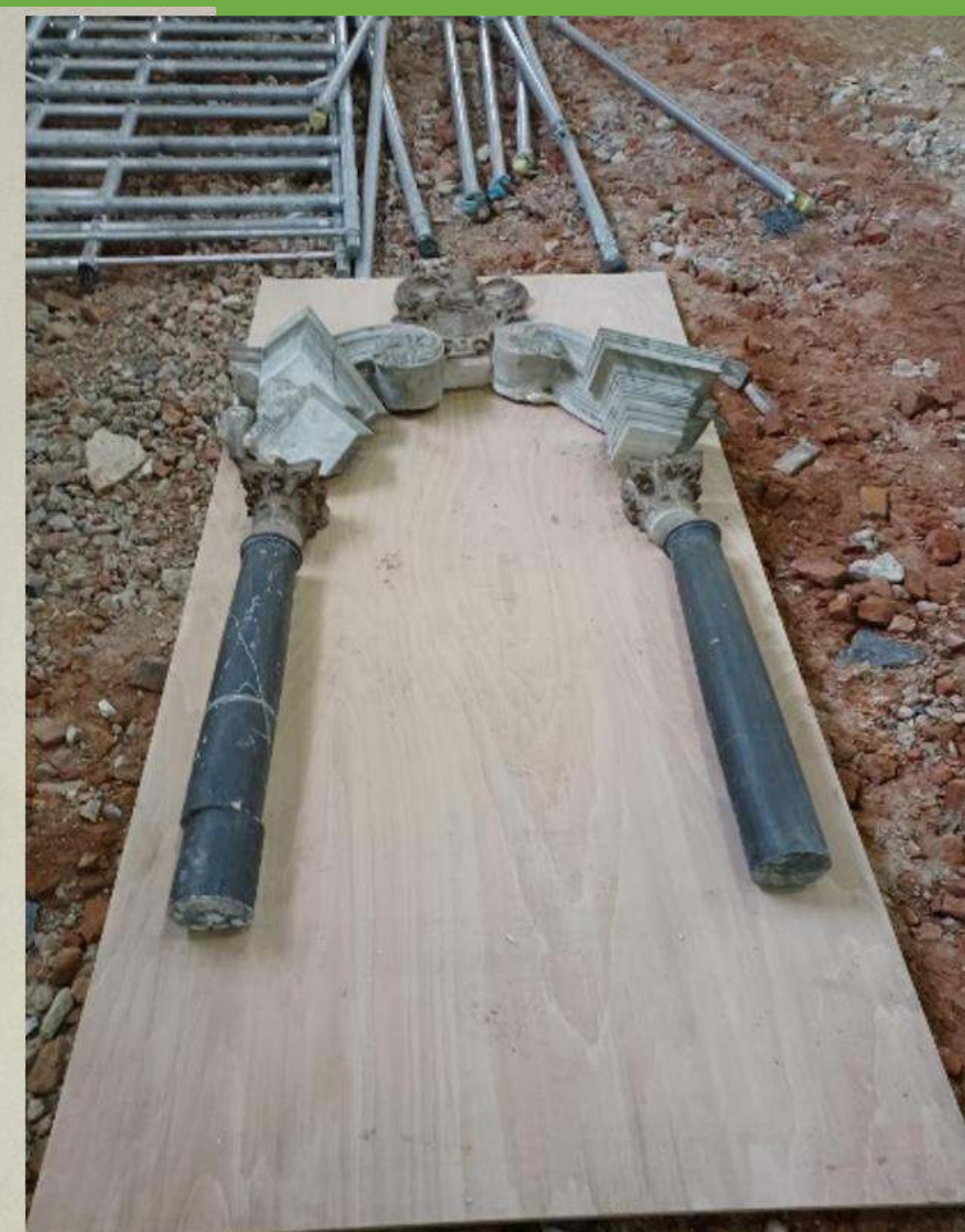








The Edward Cotton Memorial (where the north door will be) has been removed and carefully dismantled for installing further along the wall
